

10 Ways Homosexuality is Destroying America

1. Identity Crisis: The LGBT community has been steadily encouraging people to believe that it is okay to be someone that God never created them to be and live out lifestyles that God never intended for them to live. Consequently, a growing number of young people are confused about their gender and sexuality.

Practical Example: As we watch a surge of parents encouraging their kids to do things such as take puberty blockers and explore becoming a new gender, many young people are not being told that they are fearfully and wonderfully made by God. Consequently, we are witnessing many young people struggling to embrace who God had created them to be.

In the US, one survey found out that 3% of teenagers now consider themselves of an undefined gender; another survey revealed that half of the millennials thought gender was not tied to biology.

Discussion Question: How does the LGBT community benefit from a person confused about their identity?

2. Lack of Role Model: The LGBT community is helping to destroy traditional gender roles as they are adding to the confusion about the responsibilities of a man and woman within their families and communities. The LGBT community wants to get rid of organizations like the boy scouts because they want to redefine totally, what it means to be a boy or girl.

Practical Example: There are millions of males in urban communities who don't act like responsible men partly because they are not growing up with the proper male role models in their homes and communities.

57.6% of black children, 31.2% of Hispanic children, and 20.7% of white children are living absent from their biological fathers.



There are thousands of crime victims each year in cities like Chicago and Baltimore. Most of the people who are committing crimes didn't grow up with a father in their life. Why is America supporting gay marriage that often forces kids to grow up without a father?

Discussion Question: What impact do destroying gender roles have on this country?

3. Redefining Sin: The LGBT community is exposing young people's minds to unhealthy relationships like bisexuality that are destroying people's lives. Ultimately, the LGBT community is redefining what sin is in the minds of youth. Unfortunately, a growing number of people are focusing on God's grace and not understanding that He is also a God of wrath.

Practical Example: As the fear of God is being lifted from our society, fewer people are telling their kids to honor the God of the Bible with their lives. Consequently, our society is in the beginning stages of punishing individuals who believe that the Bible should be taken literally.

Some 1.3 million kids or roughly 8% of all high school students in America report being lesbian, gay, or bisexual.



If a man can suddenly transform himself into a woman, why can't a woman identify herself as a dog? These are the types of questions America is left to answer as we reject biblical values.

Discussion Question: What are some of the examples of behaviors or lifestyles that you have noticed that was once wrong, but are now right in our society?

4. Wasting Potential: Kids need to know that God created each of us on purpose, for a purpose, and for His purposes. It's critical that we understand that God expects something in return for the life He has given to each of us. If we modify who we are or choose to live lifestyles that contradicts the Bible, we jeopardize the potential God deposited inside of us to accomplish the great task that He has put us on this earth for.

Practical Example: Millions of young people are moving away from the Bible's account of how God created humankind. Meanwhile, theories like evolution and the Big Bang theory are becoming increasingly popular.

Only 38% of Americans say God created man in present form, lowest in 35 years

Discussion Question: Why is it important to let the right people help define us?

5. Destroying the image of God: One of the goals of the LGBT community is to attack God's character and make Him seem like He is almost a human. Many in the LGBT community have an image of God that is not consistent with the Bible. Consequently, many in the LGBT community often think that God made mistakes when He created humans and is an unfair God that people can't put their trust in.

Practical Example: Most millennials can't understand why God considers homosexuality as a sinful lifestyle, partially because they grew up with gay and transgender friends. The Church is losing the culture war to the LGBT community partly because we have done a poor job in showing our young people how dangerous the homosexual lifestyle has become to our civilization and Christendom.

Only 2 in 10 Americans under 30 believe attending a church is important or worthwhile (an all-time low).

Discussion Question: What does the Church need to do to help millennials overcome their negative myths about God and Christianity?

6. Political Correctness: The LGBT community is encouraging people to bully others to conform to their personal beliefs. Consequently, we are living in an ever-increasing politically correct society that is rewarding people for being easily offended and punishing others who hold firmly to some traditional values. Meanwhile, people are becoming increasingly closed minded about engaging in intelligent discussions.

Practical Example: A person can be fired from a job if they publicly say that they disagree with homosexuality.


CrossFit fired one of its employees for tweeting support of an affiliate owner in Indianapolis who canceled an LGBTQ Pride workout at his gym.

Discussion Question: Is it right to make people feel uncomfortable about living out their religious beliefs?

7. Redefining Hate: The LGBT community has helped to change the definition of hate not only to cast a negative shadow on the people who disagree with them but also to persuade their allies that they are not being hateful by putting people into negative categories like bigots. Meanwhile, the LGBT community is evolving into one of the biggest hate groups in America as they teach their members that if someone disagrees with their lifestyle, it's okay for them to be disrespectful toward them.

Practical Example: If the Church is not careful, Christians' rights to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ will be seriously hindered. It seems one of the LGBT community's goals is to deceive young people that the Church is an institution that is full of hate and not the LGBT community.

35% of millennials have an anti-church stance, believing the Church does more harm than good.



It has become convenient for groups like the LGBT community to point out how others are offending them, but they don't want to deal with the fact that they are offending God.

Discussion Question: As we watch the LGBT community try to demonize the Church, how will this influence the way Christians are both perceived and treated in the coming years?

8. Victim Mentality: I believe that the LGBT community is encouraging most of their members to see themselves as victims instead of overcomers. Victims focus on the bad things that have happened to them in the past. Overcomers focus on the great things that can happen to them in the future. It is extremely difficult to become highly successful in life if we choose to blame others for our problems.

Practical Example: Issues like learned helplessness and depression are increasingly growing among teens partly because they are being taught to focus on what others are doing to them. Some young people are not learning to take a high level of responsibility for the poor choices they make.

A study found that half of the transgender male teens have attempted suicide.

Discussion Question: In what ways is the LGBT community blaming their problems on not being accepted in our society influencing young adults?

9. Diversity Leads to Discrimination: The LGBT community is moving from fighting against discrimination to promoting more diversity among individuals. Putting members of the LGBT community into more movies, on TV and other key positions will add to the diversity of America, but also will add to the decline of our moral values as a nation. The LGBT community wants America to continue to help normalize the homosexual lifestyle by putting homosexuals in prominent positions.

Practical Example: Diversity and inclusion doesn't always help stop discrimination, but often leads to a different group of people being discriminated against.

A growing number of companies require their employees to take diversity training.



What is considered bullying has changed over the years. In a homosexual community's mind, if a Christian reads Romans 1:26-28 in a crowd of people, this is a form of bullying.

Discussion Question: In what ways is the LGBT community pushing for more diversity affecting our society?

10. Homosexual Society: The LGBT community is becoming more unreasonable in what they expect from our society. They don't care that a heterosexual and homosexual society can't co-exist. The LGBT community is still demanding things like mix-sex bathrooms. They would prefer to live in a society where parents don't raise males into men that grow up to live out traditional family values. Their goal is to change our nation into a unisex society where no one has the sense that God had put in them on this earth for a reason.

Practical Example: It is immoral to help a group of people gain a set of rights that God never ordained them to have. For example, God is not pleased with America giving the LGBT community the right to get married. Our nation is allowing the LGBT community to destroy a society that God designed for heterosexuals.

The transgender community is encouraging people to adopt gender-inclusive language like using the term "partner" instead of "husband" or "wife."

Discussion Question: How can we stop the LGBT community from destroying a society designed for heterosexual, as we are moving closer to a unisex society?

Kids are currently being taught in schools and many homes to reject the lifestyle that God has ordained them to live. Consequently, most millennials have never been properly taught on how homosexuality is destroying this nation.
